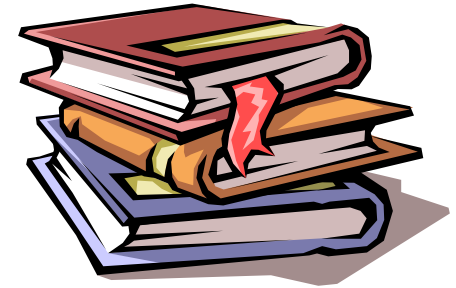

What We Accept

- Educational textbooks, in the fields of medicine, science, social science and the humanities should be current or no older than ten years
- Children's or young adult's hardcover storybooks in good condition
- College textbooks in all subjects
- Science and Math books
- Dictionaries
- Computer technology books printed no later than 2000
- Atlases should not be more than five years old.
- Encyclopedias should be the most current edition.
- Front and back covers must be attached and in tact.
- Books should be new or barely used, complete, clean and durable.
- The information on the book is up-to-date.

What We DO NOT Accept

- shabby, soiled or torn in any way
- defaced by writing poorly bound
